

Case Study Newborn's Brain Infection

Julius was a 3 month old baby with an infection in the brain. He contracted the infection from his mother, who had an active bacterial infection in the birthing canal. During labour as he passed through the birthing canal, Julius swallowed some of the bacteria which entered his blood stream. Within a few days, Julius was a very sick baby.

Julius was placed in an incubator to regulate his body temperature. He was attached to a cardiorespiratory monitor to measure his heart rate and breathing. He also needed a monitor called a pulse ox-meter to determine if there were appropriate levels of oxygen in his body. He was given antibiotics for some weeks, but he did not get better.

Julius cried all the time, day and night. He had been crying for nearly 3 months. Even his mother was not able to stop him crying.

His symptoms were:

Irregular temperature

Poor appetite and difficulty in feeding

Irritability

Rapid breathing

It was 3 am in Barcelona when I received a phone call. It was a nurse in Bolivia, where Julius lived. She was desperately asking for some help for the little baby. We exchanged e-mails and immediately started corresponding. Julius was in a special care nursery at a church in the Bolivia, where he had been taken by his mother.

It was a difficult situation. I have never tried to treat a baby by e-mail before, but as the nurse was Danish and her mother had trained in the Temprana course for her son with Lotus syndrome by her side. I decided to try.

Taking into consideration all my experience in Argentina, treating children who have suffered from an infection in the brain, I worked out a treatment plan. All those children had the biggest deposit in the Stomach area in the Step 2 map of our basic assessment in Facial Reflexology

SorensensistemTM. So, I worked out a plan to intensely stimulate the Step 2 map and the Stomach, Spleen and Pancreas areas in the Step 3 map of a basic Facial Reflexology treatment, balancing with the Stomach/ Spleen points. My underlying intention in doing this was to activate the immune system.

As additional methods, I used the Cybernetic points for the brain to activate blood flow to the brain and Cybernetic points for the Spleen to further activate the immune system.

To increase oxygen uptake of the brain, I suggested the stimulation of acupuncture point's Governor 26, 20 and the four Sisheng points.

I prescribed the use of Cranial Lines and Points for the frontal lobe of the Cortex to activate the lymphatic system too.

Newborn babies have very weak immune systems, but normally they also respond very quickly to treatment.

The above treatment plan was send by e-mail one hour after the phone call.

The next day, 8 hours after sending the treatment plan, I got an e-mail from the nurse. She was very grateful because the baby had stopped crying after his first treatment, with the Danish mother by her side, as her instructor. The baby was still sleeping and continued 6 hours – the first time in his short life.

Every day for the next 8 days, the nurse applied the basic maps of Facial Reflexology Sorensensistem™ once a day and treated Julius using the additional methods, twice a day. Julius was getting better.

His temperature was normal, he was feeding better and his breathing was normal. Sometimes he would still cry, but now his mother and even the nurse was able to stop him crying.

During the next 10 months Julius received the same treatment and little by little his condition improved. Julius had some motor problems too, but he was able to receive other kinds of rehabilitation treatments too.

One year later, I still heard about his progress. Julius can walk, smile, talk and eat all by him self.....
